## Bible Verse

We have the students memorize Bible verses that we feel are important for them to have "hidden in their heart" Each quarter they will be given a sheet with these verses.

## Prayer and Tithes

We open in prayer and we collect tithes. We encourage the students, not the parents, to give a 10th of the money they get, whether that be from an allowance, job such as babysitting, birthday money. This reminds us that the money we have is not ours, but God's.

## Lesson

We will be teaching from the Bible, so don't forget to bring your Bible and student journal for notes.

## Closing Prayer and Dismissal

We dismiss the class as a whole and you do not need to sign them out to pick them up, unless you really want to...
